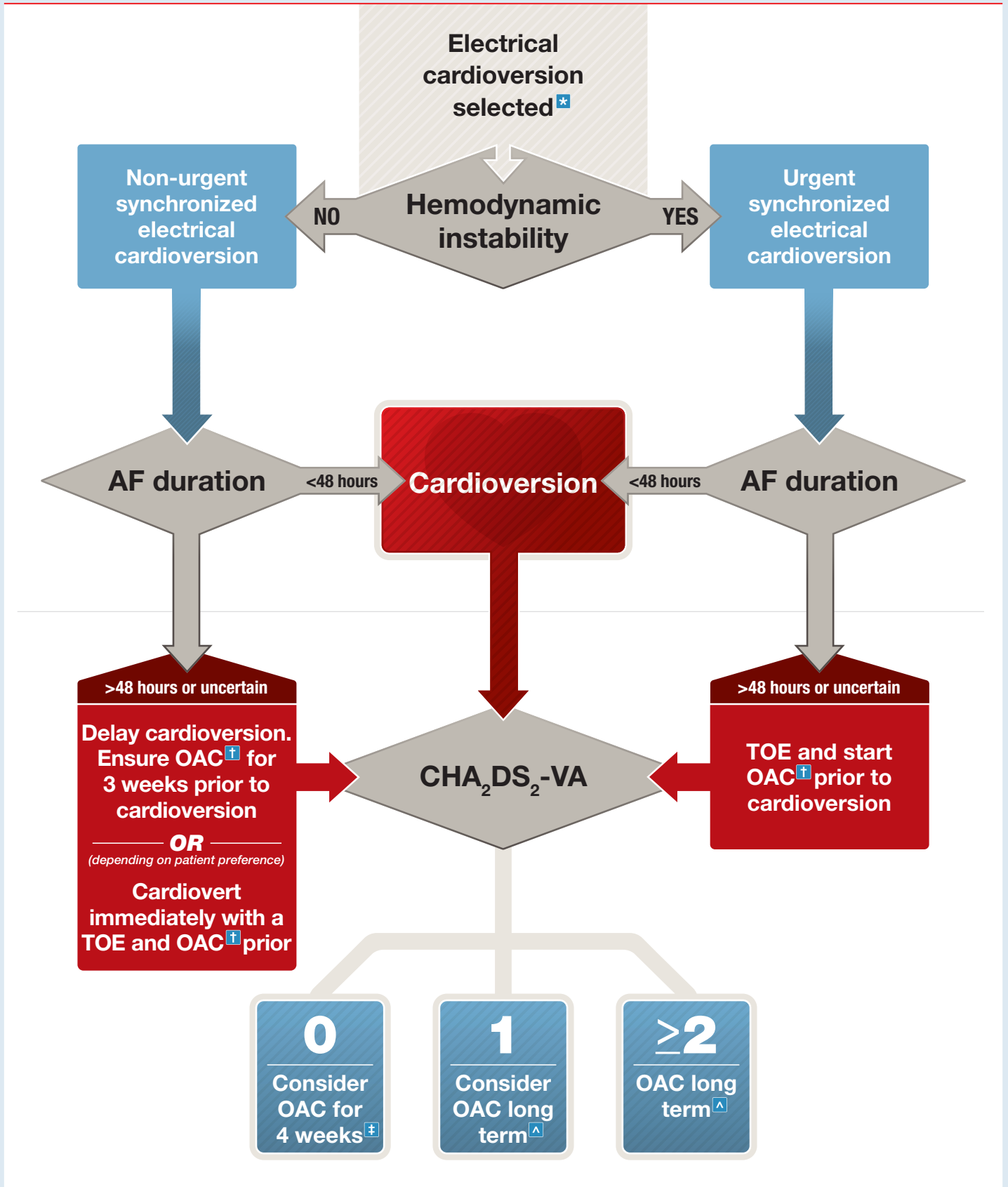


Figure 2: Electrical cardioversion
